NOTICE:

The Government of Cuba has established a new entry requirement that is effective May 1st, 2010.

Travellers visiting Cuba must present proof of health insurance to cover medical care fees that may be incurred during their trip. This insurance must be issued by a Cuban insurance entity or by a foreign insurance company recognized by Cuba.

To date, the Cuban government has not released any additional information regarding how international insurance providers will be recognized under these new regulations, nor have they indicated the cost of purchasing insurance from Cuban companies.

ETFS and Global Excel Management Inc. through whom Accerta provides our Travel Coverage, are actively monitoring this situation and have been in contact with Cuban authorities both in Cuba and Canada to obtain clarification on this issue.

ETFS and Global Excel Management will continue to honour the policies of insureds travelling to Cuba and will continue to provide services to insureds travelling there. We expect that our insureds will be able to satisfy this new requirement by presenting their insurance card and policy booklet upon request, but we are unable to guarantee this until Cuba provides additional information

In the meantime, Canadian travellers may continue to travel to Cuba, providing their return flight is prior to May 1st, 2010.
