Delisting of chiropractic coverage in Saskatchewan

Since **April 1, 2010**, chiropractic fees incurred by most residents of Saskatchewan have no longer been covered under the Saskatchewan provincial health care plan.

Prior to this date, these fees were reimbursed under this plan to a maximum of \$16.25 for the initial visit and \$12.25 for each subsequent visit.

New claims provision

In view of this change, since April 1, 2010, Desjardins Financial Security has been reimbursing the insured plan member's portion of chiropractic fees that they have incurred as of April 1, from the first dollar, for all insureds residing in Saskatchewan.

Change to Extended Health Care rates

As a result, the Extended Health Care premium rate for plans with members residing in Saskatchewan will increase by 3% at the next renewal.

Communication

In the next few days, we will be contacting all policyholders whose plans include insureds residing in Saskatchewan to inform them of these changes.
